- UNDERGROUND PIPELINE DAMAGE PREVENTION

• Effective September 1, 2007



 Any type of movement of earth or material in the ground is considered excavation.

 Anyone digging or moving earth is an excavator – including homeowners.



All excavators must call 811 before working –
 and wait the required time before beginning.

 Rules apply to excavating 16" or deeper – But is recommended no matter the depth because of erosion, landscaping, grading, etc.




Tolerance Zone

 When digging, you must stay a certain distance away from the marks on the ground when not using hand tools.

Damage

 Any type of contact with the pipeline could be considered damage depending on the severity.




Reporting

- Damages must be reported
 - To 911 if there is a release of product
 - To 811 within 1 hour of the damage
 - To the RRC via TDRF within 30 days Both the operator and the excavator.

Incidents Per Year



Damages per 1,000 Locates




Damages per Thousand Calendar Year



Root Causes




Top 10 Root Causes - Calendar Year 2018



Types of Excavator




Top Ten Types of Excavator Calendar Year 2018

Top Ten Types of Worked Performed Calendar Year 2018



- Backhoe/Trackhoe 44%
- Hand Tools 24%
- **Boring 12%**
- Unknown/Other 7%
- Auger 5%
- Trencher 4%
- Grader/Scraper 1%
- Probing Device 1%
- Directional Drilling 1%
- Drilling 1%

Typical Penalties



 Typical penalties for each violation range from \$1000 - \$2500


