
Smoke Alarms




Know what's **below**. **Call** before you dig.

- Call Police
- Offer help to the best of your ability
- See if anyone is injured
- Try to keep everyone safe

Underground Utility Line Protection Act of 1974 as amended - UULPA

- In PA, excavation with mechanized equipment without notifying 811/PA One Call is breaking the law.
- It puts people, property and the environment at risk.
- When you dig without making that call, you break the law just like the examples of:
 - Reckless driving
 - Armed robbery
 - Kidnapping




So why are we here today?


Damages with No 1 Call – All Companies 2010-2014



Average 124 per year




Top 10 Counties No1Call Damages 2010-2014






Total Damages by Construction Type 2010-2014







Lackawanna - Damages by Type Work 2011-2013



Lackawanna - No Call Damages by Type Work 2011-2013




No1Call Damages by Construction Type 2010-2014 High to Low





Making a Difference Program:

- For example; I'm driving along and see someone excavating using mechanized or powered equipment.
- Pull off the road to a safe location.
- Do you see any paint, flags or stakes designating the presence of marked underground facilities?
- If the answer is No.....

Making a Difference Program:

- Take your Tip Card and answer the following questions;
- 1) Do you know if UGI facilities exist in the area, Look for "Clear Evidence of Facilities"; meters, pipeline markers, etc.
- 2) Determine the actual address or street name & name of the closest intersecting street(s). The more descriptive and detailed the better.
- 3) Include the County and Municipality you are located in.
- 4) Do you see a company name on the equipment at the site, if so document the name and any other specific info. Photos work great!
- 5) Never become confrontational with anyone on site.


Making a Difference by Preventing Damages

If you see someone excavating without any type of field markings such as paint, flags or other means of identifying underground facilities, do the following:

- 1. Call 811 and report a possible excavation with No 1 Call
- 2. Follow reporting instructions on opposite panel.
- 3. If you are a UGI Field employee notify Dispatch as well.
- 4. If you have E-mail also notify No1call@ugi.com of your report.

Reporting Instructions: (See Checklist on back)

- 1. In what municipality and county is the site located?
- What is the street name and is there a house with an address nearby, if so provide the number.
- 3. What is the nearest intersection to the site?
- 4. Can you identify any company names on the vehicles?

Making A Difference Program

To Report:


- Call 811 to report a No1Call, provide detailed information
 - In 2016, the PA One Call Board approved an Emergency Ticket to be issued when an excavation site is reported where a No1Call exists
 - So not only UGI employees can call, anyone in the state can report a potential excavation with No1Call.
- A notification will go to all utilities in the area with facilities.



Making A Difference Program

- If the excavator will not cease, local law enforcement can be contacted to stop the excavation as it falls under Title 18 PA Constitutional Statute §3202, Causing or Risking Catastrophe and is also covered in the UULPA Fines and Penalties Section.
 - Don't assume all law enforcement is aware of this.
- If the location is confirmed to be an excavation site with No1Call, the UGI Employee receives 5000 "Making a Difference Points".

Total Damages Gas Division 2011-2014 Fiscal Years





Pennsylvania Map plotting No1 Call Reports 1-1-19 to 9-30-19 288 No One Call Tickets have been received.






UGI Employees

- Of the 288 No One Call Tickets placed into the PA One Call System:
 - 80 of them were from UGI Utilities, Inc. Employees
 - 58 of them were positive reports
 - 58 potential catastrophes avoided.



The percentages with No1Call in that area are staggering.

- •Tioga 84/29 = 35%
- Potter 47/13 = 28%
- •Bradford 31/8 = 26%
- •McKean 23/12 = 52%
- •Clarion 10/7 = 70%
- Venango 4/1 = 25%
- •Forest 2/1 = 50%

Route 6 Corridor

- Route 6 Corridor 5 YR 2015 2019
 - Total = 201/71 = **35%**
- All UGI 2015 2019,
 - 2336/347 = **14.8%**
- Opportunity to ramp up efforts to promote the No1Call program in that area.
- Challenges-
 - Rural area
 - Advertising is limited
 - Outreach/Mailing being discussed for the Spring

No One Call Program & Emergency Ticket

To a reasonable person the national damage statistics are compelling.

Common Ground Alliance shares:

When you call 811 before digging you reduce the chance of damage to less than 1%, great odds.

Every 9 minutes an underground utility is damaged because someone did not Call 811. It's three numbers, actually two, one twice..

In 2016 the Pa One Call Board approved an Emergency Ticket to be issued when an excavation site is reported where No One Call exists

As a result, several PA companies have employee-based reporting programs.



Marked Site Examples







Clear Evidence of Facilities



- Scan the street.
- •Previous utility marks, trench lines.
- •Manhole cover, valve lids, fire hydrants, pipeline markers, meters, regulators, transformers, etc.











So what happens when a report is submitted?


- A search of the PA One Call data base will be conducted for a valid ticket for the reported location.
- There could be a ticket and it was cleared ,meaning we have no facilities in area.
- If we do have facilities or can't confirm we are clear or the location was previously evaluated, we will send a company representative to the site to determine if we have facilities within the excavation area and take appropriate action to protect our facilities.
- If the excavator will not cease, local law enforcement can be contacted to stop the excavation as it falls under Title 18 PA Constitutional Statute §3202, Causing or Risking Catastrophe and is also covered in the UULPA Fines and Penalties Section.
- If caller receives a \$25 Sheetz Gift Card if the location is confirmed to be an excavation site with No One Call.




TNB - Tickets Near By Tool:

- Developed at POCS Member request
- Field pilots using smart phones were conducted by PPL Electric & UGI Utilities.
- Enhancements made based on user feedback
- Proactive tool to confirm valid 1Call @ Ground Zero
- Can be integrated into Facility Owner programs aimed at reducing damages
- TNB is currently available to Facility Owners as it is geo based using CDC Call Directing Code.
- Next step is to report No1Calls using TNB

Review - Sequence of Events



Form given to our 1st responders who will report to the site.

What to do when you receive an Emergency One Call ticket for a "No One Call".

Pennsylvania Facility Owners, including UGL, have barned together with PA One Call to adopt a program to report sites where excavation, using mechanized equipment, is underway and no markings or flags are present. These illegal excavations put our employees and the public at risk. UGI has an incentive based, employee driven program, "No1Call Reporting", and has developed a Tip Card to assist employees in reporting these illegal activities. The process begins with a call to \$11, who in turn creates an Emergency One Call notification, that is distributed to all Facility Owners in the reported dig area.



In the event you receive such an Emergency One Call follow the guidance below:


- As a 1° Responder to this type emergency notification you do not require Task 29 Locate skills as this One Call notification is NOT to complete a locate in these cases but rather, as a representative of UGI, determine if the execusior has a valid One Call ticket and if potentially our facilities are at risk.
- Additionally, the One Call you received is not a valid dig ticket for the individual doing the
 excavating. In PA the person doing the digging must make the call in order to be a valid ticket.
 The escavator is in violation of the Law and is required to place their own ticket before
 proceeding, we would ONLY mark out for a 2nd ticket.
- If they don't produce a copy of a One Call ticket or a serial number, ask them to stop excavating and place a call to 811 before they proceed with excavation.
- If the contractor is not cooperative or confinentational, DO NOT CONFRONT THEM, return to your vehicle and notify your Supervisor and 911.
- Law Enforcement and Emergency Management personnel have a provision under the One Call
 Law and Title 18 for "Risking or Causing a Catastrophe" to stop the excavator from digging
 without a valid One Call Ticket.
- Additional support can be provided by reaching out to the Pipeline & Public Safety Team directly or at Not Call Stagicom



Eligibility & Rules:


- •All UGI Utilities Gas & Electric Employees are eligible.
- The reported location must be in the UGI Utilities franchised service territory.
- The report may not be the result of a damage to a UGI facility.
- In the event there are multiple reports for the same location the earliest report will receive points.
