# MICHIGAN EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT ACT

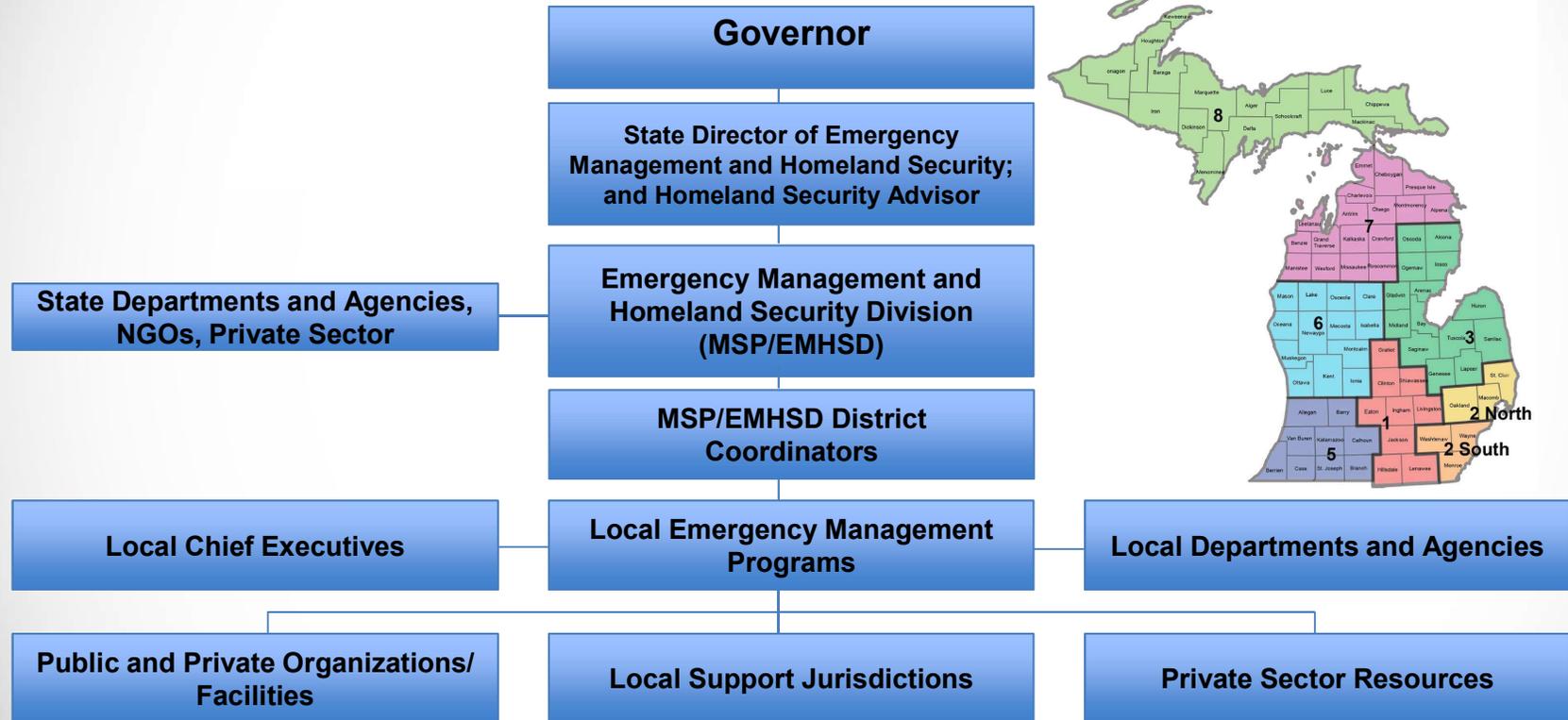
Public Act 390 of 1976

# EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT STRUCTURE

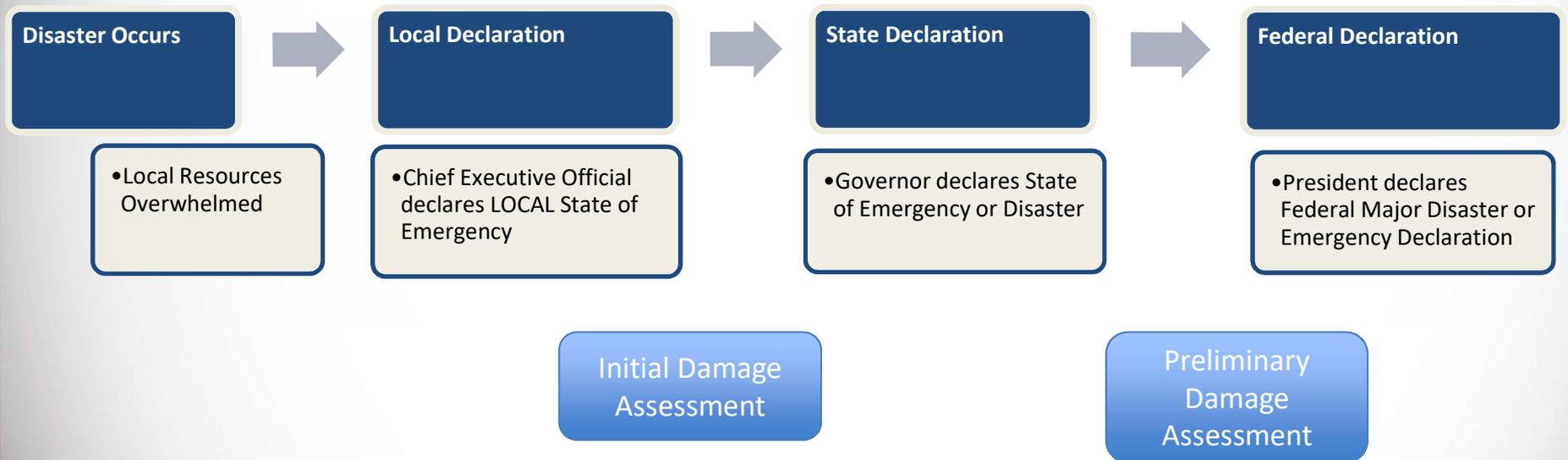


# ABOUT MSP/EMHSD

- Coordinates local, state and federal emergency management and homeland security activities across Michigan.
- Manages operations of the State Emergency Operations Center.
- Coordinates the utilization of state assets during and after emergencies and disasters.
- Coordinates various EM and HS federal grants.
- Provides training to state and local emergency responders.
- Prepares and maintains the Michigan Emergency Management Plan (MEMP).



# EMERGENCY/DISASTER PROCESS



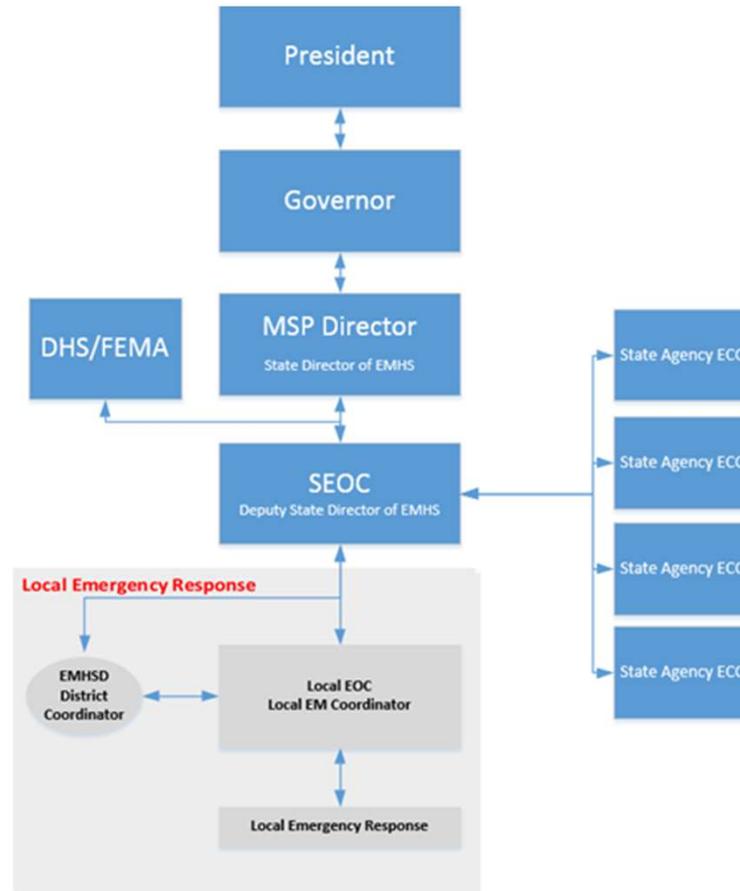
# STATE EMERGENCY OPERATIONS CENTER (SEOC)

Set update interval for maps to 7:00 PM daily. New map refocuses efforts on residential only, and highlights only filter distributions for coverage.</li><li>• Released updated JIC map at 1800 displaying updated field team activity and integrating historic paper records that have been entered into the tracking system for field team activity.</li><li>• Configured an interface with AGOL to allow MDARD to live update food and water establishment statuses as it relates to the incident. Plan on building a dashboard to monitor status of these facilities for display in the SEOC.</li><li>• Coordinated with Flint City GIS to gather total counts for buildings and units per parcel. Still not delivered, but meeting late in the day confirmed the data is available.</li><li>• Built a data entry tool and deployed to the documentation unit for paper forms from field teams.
