WHAT OCCURRED? MANDATORY WORK FROM HOME BEGAN END OF MARCH 2020




- Overnight our PS&E Team was re-directed on reaching out to our community partners/businesses to create a "Community Resource Listing" to better help assist our customers on location resources available within our service area.
- This required consistent daily updates to keep our listing relevant on current resources available and reaching out for newer resources, all to better assist our customers within our community.
- Any and all kinds of assistance available was being captured.
- During this short period of time (April 2020) PS&E Presentations were non-existent



TEAMS FOCUS REDIRECTED HOW ARE WE GOING TO ENGAGE OUR COMMUNITY?

Team began brainstorming ideas for Community Engagement Live/Virtual Events and the challenges with new technology:

- Social Media (Facebook Live?)
- WebEx How do you use it?
- Microsoft Teams How does it work?
- Zoom We cannot download on company equipment, but we can utilize Zoom only if our community partner sets it up and invites us.



CHALLENGES & OPPORTUNITIES



OPPORTUNITIES:

- We were not alone
- Immediately went to the "low hanging fruit"
 - Making phone calls and using our SWN system
 - Mailing and emailing information to our customers and partners
 - Utilized Community Networks and Connections
 - Leveraged the limited gatherings happening in person

CHALLENGES:

- Overnight leveraged technology to keep the community informed
- Utilized social media
 - Good for small amounts of information, however anyone can post anything

LOCATION SETUP



 Determine best location to be utilized to have the greatest chance for a safe successful event.



GATHERING THE RIGHT MATERIALS CPS



- If you are selected by the team to conduct the presentation, ensure you find ways to acquire ALL needed materials for a successful presentation to include:
 - Props, Hazard Hamlet, Tablecloth, Head-set, etc.



CONFIGURATION



Depending on location chosen to present, the team needed to schedule adequate time before the presentation date to set-up a safe, functional, configuration conducive to the specific needs and style of presentation to engage the audience efficiently.






